## **TERMS OF REFERENCE**

PROVISION OF QUALITY MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS AUDIT AND CERTIFICATION TO ISO 9001:2015 1 LOT FOR ANGAT WATER DISTRICT WHOLE PROCESS

#### I. INTRODUCTION

The ANGAT WATER DISTRICT (AWD) aims to meet their mission of providing safe, reliable and high-quality water. It is important therefore that the AWD device mechanism to enhance customer satisfaction thru a significantly improved and reliable service to its concessionaires.

Pursuant to Executive Order No. 605, approved on February 23, 2007 and the Guidelines on the grant of the performance-Based Bonus for Fiscal Year 2019 under Executive Order No. 80 s. 2012 and Executive No. 201 s. 2016 prescribing the criteria and conditions for the grant of the PBB for 2019, AWD hereby seeks to hire a certifying body to obtain an ISO 9001:2015 Certification.

#### II. OBJECTIVE

The ANGAT WATER DISTRICT (AWD) will procure and engage the services of a Certifying Body that will conduct an assessment and audit of AWD's quality management system as pre-requisite for ISO Certification and periodic surveillance audits thereafter prior to renewal of the said ISO Certification.

#### III. PROJECT SITE

The project site will be at Angat Water District Office.

## IV. NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES

Ten (10) AWD permanent employees shall take part in the Quality Management Systems Audit.

#### V. SCOPE OF SERVICES

## VI. DURATION OF SERVICES

The services subject of the procurement shall be for a period of one (1) year starting CY 2020 to 2021.

# VII. CONTRACT PERIOD

The contract period or term for the service described in this Term of Reference (TOR) shall be one (1) year from the date of the official notice issued by the AWD. It is expected that the Certifying Body shall initiate the services, as agreed, after receipt of Job Order and Notice to Proceed.

## VIII. DOCUMENTS AND ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Valid Registration Certificate from Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC), Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) for sole proprietorship or Cooperative Development Authority (CDA) for cooperatives. If SEC Registration Certificate is the applicable proof of registration, it must be submitted together with the following documents:
  - a. Complete Articles of Incorporation, Partnership or Cooperation, whichever is applicable, including amendments thereto, if any; and
  - b. General Information Sheet (GIS) duly received by the SEC, reflecting the existing stockholders
- Valid Mayor's/Business Permit issued by the city or municipality where the principal place of business of the prospective bidder is located or equivalent documents for Exclusive Economic Zones or Areas;

In case of recently expired Mayor's Business permits, it shall be accepted together with the official receipt as proof that the bidder has applied for renewal within the period prescribed by the local government unit, provided that the renewed permit shall be submitted as a post qualification requirement in accordance with Section 34.2 of the IRR RA 9184. (Sec. 24.1 (a) (ii) of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184)

For individual consultant not registered under sole proprietorship, a BIR Certificate of Registration shall be submitted, in lieu of DTI registration and Mayor's/Business permit;

- 4. With at least three (3) years of ISO 9001 auditing experience
- 5. Statement of the prospective bidder of its ongoing and completed projects supported with Certificate of satisfactory completion for each of the completed projects
- 6. List of auditors who will conduct the audit and their corresponding curriculum vitae stating therein their complete qualifications and experience data
- 7. The Certifying Body Audit Team, including Surveillance should satisfy the following:

- 1. Consist of at least two (2) auditors with actual hands-on experience on QMS who are qualified to conduct audits in the name of the Certifying Body,
- 2. Members shall have relevant industry or sector specific audit experience in QMS
- Accreditation Certificate from the Philippine Accreditation Bureau (PAB) of the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) conforming to PNS ISO/IEC 17021-1:2015 and PNS ISO/IEC TS 17021-3:2014 to provide QMS Certification to ISO 9001:2015 for the scope IAF27 Water Supply.
- 9. PhilGEPS Registration Number
- 10. Omnibus Sworn Statement in accordance with Section 25.3 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act 9184.

# IX. SELECTION CRITERIA

The procurement of the Consultant shall be based on applicable government laws, rules and procedures.

The evaluation shall be based on the Quality-Cost Based Evaluation (QCBE) Procedure wherein the Technical Proposal together with the Financial Proposal shall be considered.

The criteria and rating system for the selection of the winning Certifying Body are a follows:

- b. Comprehensiveness
  - o Completeness of activities as outlined in the TOR
  - Logical sequence of activities
  - Appropriate timing of the activities
  - o Flexible enough, so that it can be modified easily, if necessary

## The Financial Proposal

1. The approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) shall be the upper limit or ceiling for acceptable Financial Proposal. Financial Proposal received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected.

- 2. The Financial Proposal shall be computed as follows:
  - a. The lowest Financial Proposal shall receive the maximum score of 40%.
  - b. The scores of other Financial Proposals shall be computed using the formula:

Financial Score = Lowest Financial Proposal/Financial Proposal of the Proponent x 100 x 40%.

## **Overall Rating**

The overall rating of the proponent shall be the sum of the ratings earned for the Technical Proposal and Financial Proposal.

The contract shall be awarded to the Highest Rated Bid.

# X. APPROVED BUDGET FOR THE CONTRACT

The Approved Budget for the contract is Ninety Thousand Pesos (P90,000.00) and shall be deemed to include the cost of all taxes, duties, fees, levels and other charges imposed under applicable law.
